It has been well established that the constant or promiscuous use of caustic antiseptic solutions for douches, or vaginal solutions and jellies containing bichloride of mercury or carbolic acid, are not only injurious, but if persisted in, tend to injure the delicate mucous membranes, sometimes causing permanent harm.

BYROL is harmless, non-irritating, non-poisonous, stainless and greaseless, delicately scented. Its germicidal powers are remarkable. The time required to insure complete vaginal antiseptics is only about thirty seconds. It can be used with absolute safety upon the most delicate parts and surfaces. BYROL also has a delightful deodorant action. Composed of Lactic Acid, Chinosol and

Boric Acid which are incorporated in a soothing jelly-base, BYROL offers to physicians a preparation for their patients that is a decided advance in maintaining safe and satisfactory feminine hygiene.

HOW TO USE BYROL

BEFORE retiring or whenever else required, remove red rubber cap from the nozzle of the tube and then insert the long neck (or nozzle) of the tube into the vagina as far as possible. (It is to be noted that the nozzle of the tube is just the right size and will penetrate its full length when pressed in and down.)

Now with the tube in the above-described position squeeze out the entire contents of one tube of BYROL into the vaginal cavity, pressing the tube as it is being withdrawn. The soothing BYROL jelly thus forms practically a physical barrier to the entrance of the cervix which opens on the uterus at the same time that the whole vaginal passage is made antiseptic and safe.

This application of BYROL will spread an antiseptic and protective film of BYROL over the entire vaginal tract. One of the advantages of BYROL is the fact that douching is unnecessary. If desired, however, a douche of warm water may be taken, but not sooner than eight to ten hours after the application of BYROL.

A NEW ERA IN VAGINAL APPLICATION
